

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TRANSLATOR'S PREFACE

THERE ARE MANY OTHER BOOKS ON GREEK METRE, BUT THEY ARE UNSATISFACTORY IN CONTENT AND STYLE MOST OF THEM HAVE BEEN WRITTEN BY GERMANS AND THEREFORE SMELL OF THE CLASSROOM RATHER THAN THE FIELD.

YOU WILL FIND IN THEM NO LIVING IONICS, BAC-CHIACS, OR CHORIAMBS GRAZING SLOPPILY IN THEIR NATIVE MARSHES, BUT ONLY THE TIDY SKEL-ETONS PRESERVED GERMAN MUSEUMS. FOR EXAMPLE, ONE STANDARD TEXT BOOK GIVES ONLY THE BONES OF THE IONIC:

WHEREAS THE LIVING-CREATURE LOOKS LIKE THIS:



THE BRITISH, WHO ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR MANY OF THESE BOOKS, ARE TOO PRIM TO TREAT ADEQUATELY A SUBJECT THAT REQUIRES EXTENSIVE HANDLING OF THE ITHY-PHALLIC.

MOREOVER, MOST BOOKS ON METRE ARE AS POOR IN STYLE AS THEY ARE IN CON-TENT: EITHER POMPOUS AND WORDY OR TERSE AND INCOMPREHENSIBLE AS AN ORACLE.


